Please find the following Coquetdale Community Message update covering the period 1st March to the 1st April 2015.

Five (5) x crimes were reported over this period:

### **Rothbury**

#### **Arson to a static caravan**

Occurred between 10/08/14 and 05/03/15 at Little Tosson Farm.

The caravan owner visited his static caravan which had been situated on farm land with consent and found his caravan had been completely destroyed by fire.

#### **Assault (Actual Bodily Harm)**

Occurred 22/03/15 in the area of Thropton where the female victim (54 yrs) suffered facial injuries following a domestic incident.
